#### **Situation:**

The initialization program labeled 6060B on page 3-33 of the 6060B/6033B Service Manual (p/n 5951-2828) will not initialize the EEPROM due to a missing word in the command strings. Any command errors generated by the faulty commands are cleared by the "\*RST" command at the end of the program, and then the EEPROM appears to have been initialized properly when in fact it hasn't been initialized.

#### **Solution/Action:**

"\*SAV 0"

Replace the initialization program on page 3-31 of the 6060A Service Manual (p/n 06060-90003) so it agrees with the following program.
