Situation:

A change to the 10811E design caused a change to the 10811E's power-on current resulting in tripping the instrument's current limit circuit.

Solution/Action:

If a power on failure occurs on turn-on, turn power off, disconnect the instrument from line voltage and disconnect the 10 MHz from the mother board. Reconnect line voltage and turn the instruments power on. If the instrument turns on without a power failure indication, replace the 10 MHz standard. With the 10 MHz reference disconnected there will be an unlock messages displayed.

Part number 1813-1258 does not have this problem. Products other than the 836xx series may not have a problem with the higher turn-on current. The 10811E inventory may be used for other products.
