Solution/Action:

Follow these steps to properly protect the floptical drive.

- 1) To properly protect the head of the floptical drive, insert a 5182-0984 floptical head protector in the drive when it is not in use, especially if the unit will be moved around. This includes, but is not limited to, movement of the system from bench to bench and/or removal of the SCSI disk module from the VXI mainframe.
- 2) Do not move the E4208 around when there is a floptical diskette in the drive. This can cause damage to both the drive and the diskette. A diskette is NOT a substitute for the Floptical Head Protector card p/n 5182-0984.
- 3) When shipping the drive, the drive module, or a system containing the module make certain that it is well protected from shock. Popcorn is not a good shock insulator, as the drive may shift around in the box. Ensure that the shipping container is well padded on all sides.
