Situation:

Automatically shut down after a few seconds beeping occurs when user turns on the instrument. This is due to CPU Fan rotor dropped off.

Solution/Action:

Trouble isolation and action needed

1. Push down CPU fan's rotor using something like tooth pick just after turning on power switch.



2. If CPU fan rotates, then the cause of the trouble is [dropped off rotor]



- 2-1. If CPU fan is COFAN, replace CPU fan with a new one (3160-4452) for repair.
- 2-2. If CPU fan is COOLER MASTER, replace the whole CPU assembly with E5061-62170.

3. If CPU fan does not rotate, replace the whole CPU assembly with E5061-62170.
